

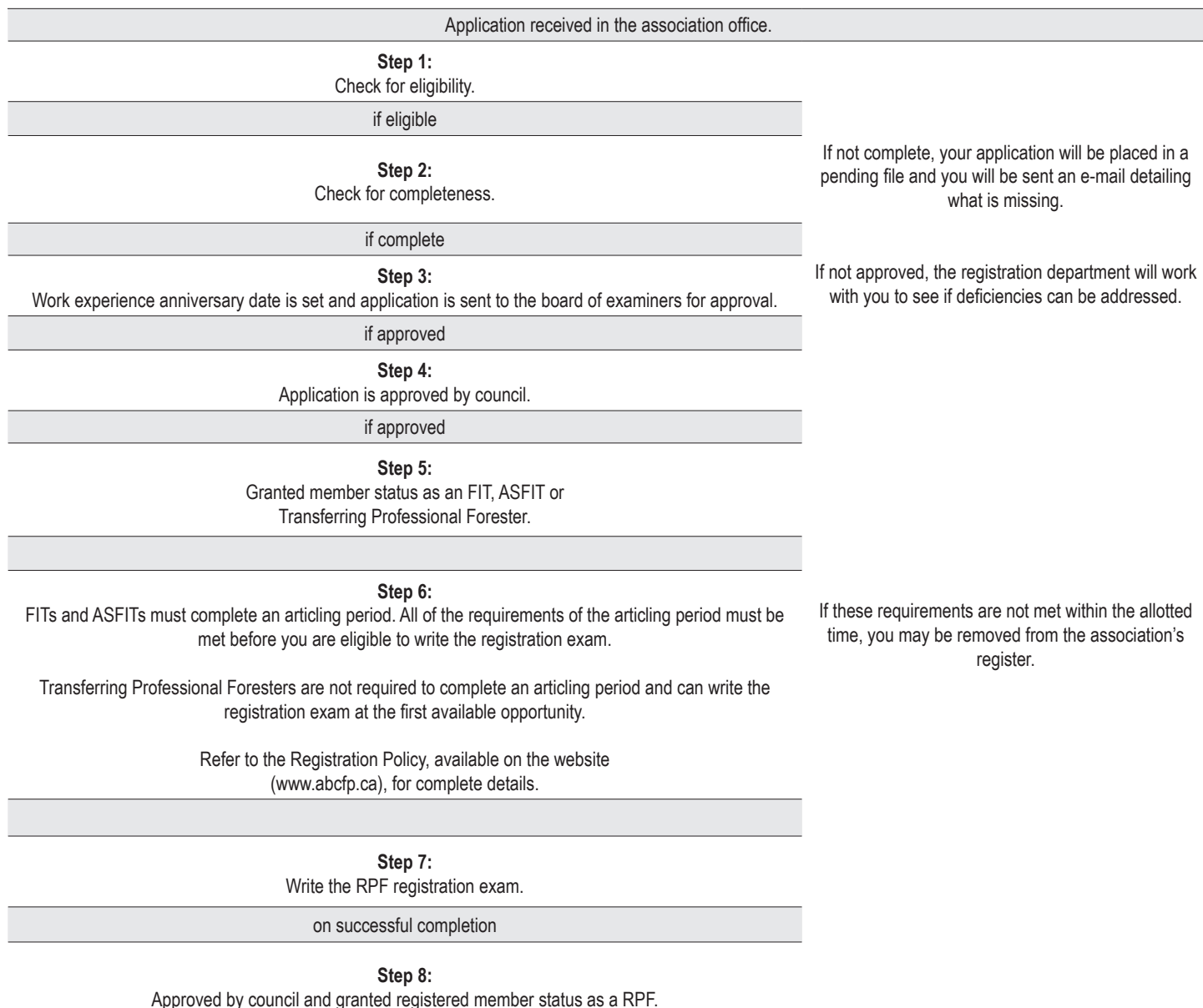
Registered Professional Forester Application Process Chart

You must be a registered member with the Association of BC Forest Professionals (ABCFP) to practise professional forestry in BC. The ABCFP is the registering and regulatory body for BC's forest professionals, including Registered Professional Foresters (RPFs) and Registered Forest Technologists (RFTs).

Once you have determined your eligibility under the Forester in Training (FIT), Allied Science Forester in Training (ASFIT) or Transferring Professional Forester routes of entry (refer to the eligibility chart), complete the RPF Application Package in order to apply for membership. All documents can be found on the ABCFP website (www.abcfp.ca).
