

# AIT / TILMA Exam

## Notes to Examinees



There are two (2) pages of questions.

**Read all instructions and questions carefully.** Allocate your time wisely to ensure that you complete the exam within the time allotted.

All answers must be recorded in the answer books provided. **Do not write any answers on the question sheets and you must return them to the invigilator with your answer books after the exam.**

### I. EXAM AND BREAK TIMES

The exam is two (2) hours long and will begin promptly at 9 am and will end exactly at 11 am. You must stop writing at 11 am, immediately turn in your used and unused answer books to the invigilator then leave the exam room. Unless a different start/end period has been pre-arranged with and has been approved by the Registration Dept., these times must not be exceeded.

### II. WRITING THE EXAM

**YOU MUST RECORD ALL QUESTION NUMBERS YOU SELECTED TO ANSWER ON THE COVER OF YOUR FIRST ANSWER BOOK ONLY.** You must also indicate the number of answer books you used in the space provided on the top right corner of your answer book.

1. Questions are worth ten (10) marks each. Answer format for each question will be either:
  - **Essay:** Questions requiring essay format answers will be labelled with the word (**Essay**). You must answer essay questions using complete sentences and paragraphs.
  - **Short Answer:** Questions requiring only short answers will be labelled with the words (**Short Answer**). Short answers may include point form statements.
2. To pass the exam, you must achieve 60% or higher.
3. **Select and answer only four (4) of the seven (7) questions** [for 40 marks]
4. If you begin to answer a question and then decide to exclude it, you must clearly indicate this by crossing out the answer entirely.
5. If you answer more than four (4) questions, the Board of Examiners will accept and mark only your first four (4) answers. All subsequent answers will be voided.
