Best BC Forest Professional Article

(Award for Members and Non-members)

Overview & Criteria

The Best **BC Forest Professional** Article award annually recognizes an individual who wrote an outstanding article that was published in the Association of BC Forest Professionals' magazine, **BC Forest Professional** (BCFP).

The award is given for an article that demonstrates some or all of the following:

- possesses superior writing quality
- involves a topic that is of interest to the membership
- is thought provoking
- contains original content
- advances the profession
- demonstrates critical thinking
- reflects the professionalism of the membership

The article must have been submitted by the individual for publication in BCFP. Articles the editorial board selected from other sources for reprinting will not be considered. Letters to the editor will not be considered (see Best **BC Forest Professional** Letter award).

This award was first created in 1997 and was originally limited to articles written by ABCFP members. In 2004, the eligibility was opened to include articles written by non-members as well.

Eligibility

ABCFP members and non-members are eligible for this award. Articles written by council or staff are not eligible.

Nominations

After each issue of BCFP is released, the editorial board will nominate the best article published in the issue based on the above noted criteria.

Selection Process

Recipients are selected by council based on recommendation of the editorial board.

Presentation

This award is usually announced at the President's Awards Banquet during ExpoFor. No formal presentation will be made.
